Over the past 100 years, the appearance of the historic Posthotel has changed several times, and since 2021 it has been rebuilt. The hotel is scheduled to open in November 2023.

With 60 km of pistes prepared to the highest standard, 60 km of superbly maintained winter hiking trails and a diverse winter sports offering, Arosa has something for everyone. Because of the Arosa Lenzerheide ski area connection, 225 kilometers of well prepared slopes have been available since January 2014.

Pedestrians in Arosa have plenty of options for winter hikes or can use the network of lifts to take them directly to the ski resort, where they can enjoy time with their loved ones amidst the breath-taking mountain landscape.

As well as watching bears at the famous Arosa Bear Sanctuary, tobogganing, ice-skating, paragliding and romantic horse-drawn carriage rides, guests can also take part in the weekly taster course for curling. Nature lovers can enjoy our beautiful snowy winter landscape with a cross-country skiing or snow shoe tour.

The Arosa Lenzerheide winter sports resort in Graubünden is a destination par excellence, with superbly prepared pistes, lots of rustic mountain huts and record-breaking hours of sunlight. Arosa and Lenzerheide are connected by the spectacular "Urdenbahn" aerial tramway, which soars above the Urdental valley and transports winter holidaymakers from Arosa Hörnli to Urdenfürggli in Lenzerheide (or back) in under five minutes.

The Arosa Lenzerheide winter sports paradise has something for everyone: kids zones for budding winter athletes, snow parks for action lovers, or expertly prepared pistes to suit skiers and snowboarders of all ages and skill levels. Winter hiking

Winter hiking in Arosa, Langwies, on the mountain, at Untersee lake or in Hochwang. No matter which area you choose, you'll find a winter hiking option to suit you. Arosa has more than 60 km of prepared walking and winter hiking paths that lead to all mountain huts through the vibrant winter sports resort or through snow-capped forests. This means that visitors on foot also have the opportunity to spend some time in the region's cosy, serviced huts.

As you hike the winter trail, you can enjoy the breathtaking mountain landscape, use the state-of-the-art transport facilities such as the Urdenbahn aerial tramway, and replenish your tanks in one of the many cosy mountain restaurants.





Snowshoeing

Arosa features 30 km of pre–prepared classic and skating trails.

Arosa Bear Sanctuary

The Arosa Bear Sanctuary is an experience for young and old. The resident bears, Meimo and Amelia, are the main attraction. The Arosa Bear Sanctuary provides a species-appropriate home for bears rescued from living in poor conditions. Bears who were previously forced to live in a tiny, dirty cage were freed from this awful situation by the animal welfare organisation FOUR PAWS and then brought to Arosa.

The bears can learn their natural behaviours in the heart of the natural mountain landscape with meadows, bushes, rocks, streams and forest. And visitors can watch them doing this.

The Arosa Bear Sanctuary animal protection project is run by the FOUR PAWS animal welfare organisation and the Arosa Bear Foundation.

Experiences at the Arosa Bear Sanctuary

When you visit the bear platform at over 2000m above sea level, you will learn many interesting facts about bears in the exhibition as well as the histories of the bears from Albania. The adventure route with its suspension bridges in the northern enclosure, the bear-themed mini golf, the adventure playground at the middle station, the "Weisshornbär" view point and the Bear Sanctuary experience trail all add to the fun. Then feed your hungry bear family at the Brüggerstuba restaurant next door.

The Arosa Bear Sanctuary is open every Thursday from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. The animals spend the winter months in hibernation, but it is still worth a visit. If you are lucky, you will be able to observe the bears hibernating in their outdoor enclosure – a unique spectacle. The animal keepers are always happy to talk about the latest happenings at the Arosa Bear Sanctuary and the behaviour of the bears. Guests can learn interesting facts at first hand.





Mountain Experiences

The Arosa Lenzerheide snow sports region has much more to offer than 225 kilometres of pistes. Night owls and early risers experience very special moments during the mountain experiences.

Culture in Schanfigg

The Schanfigg valley is known for its preserved culture and traditional settlements. The settlement structure has changed little since the 19th century and, for the most part, – apart from Arosa – retains its agricultural character. The oldest building in Schanfigg, the Lüen church, is from the 11th century and the oldest residences date back to the 17th century. This culture is best discovered with a guided tour or winter walk. We also recommend trying the local specialities at one of the numerous farm shops.
